

### EU and EU HPC activities:

- Will have a meeting with Prof. A. Brinkmann (Univ. Mainz) to discuss EU-related activities and EOFS involvement.
- Meeting planned for 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2019



### **Elections of the EOFS Administrative Council:**

- Members have to elect 6 members to the EOFS AC.
- Only members or representatives of members (by transferred vote) can vote
- One vote per member
- Voting weight is proportional to the subscribed share
- The AC will then elect a president, vicepresident and two directors.



### **New EOFS Members:**

- Dell and Fujitsu have shown interest to join
- HLRS will join (already approved by Michael Resch)
- Working on all major vendors to become members
- Important: A few members that have joined after the foundation of EOFS have to complete a special form required by the legal procedures of a Societas Europaea.
